#### TWO DISCIPLES KILLED AND MANY OTHER INJURED FROM BANDIT ATTACKS

In Niger and Kebbi states, many of our people are displaced for over two weeks now.

We keep praying for them, and communicating with them to receive situational reports and encourage them.

The missionaries are now camped in a secondary school, where they are waiting to return to their lands.

- More souls won to the Lord Jesus.


