Pioneering Missions in 3 Additional Countries:

1. Ivory Coast
2. Chad
3. Guinea Bissau



Ivory Coast Missions



We pioneered mission work in Ivory Coast in July. We praise God for helping us to co-labour with Him among the natives. About 635 souls were won to the Lord and 1 new church was planted.

CHAD MISSIONS

We give glory to God for the success of the missionary journey to Chad in the month of July. We were able to preach the good news among the unreached, and about 100 decisions were made for Christ. 40 leaders were trained and 2 new churches were planted.



GUINEA BISSAU MISSIONS

We embarked on an outreach to this country in the month of August, and indeed the Lord came through for us. 250 souls were won, 5 indigenous missionaries trained and 3 new churches were planted there by God's grace.



CAMEROON AND SENEGAL MISSIONS

We visited the countries of Cameroon and Senegal in the month of July and August respectively. The message of the Gospel was shared with many, and 587 souls were saved. 71 leaders were also trained.



TOGO MISSIONS

Just recently, we returned from our missionary trip to Togo. Thankfully, 3 volunteers joined the team on this journey and that was a great encouragement. A total of 12 villages were visited and about 200 souls saved.

In all our missionary endeavours, we saw the power of God at work to save and to deliver. Bibles, foodstuffs and other relief materials were distributed to bless the people. We are grateful to all our partners who support us in prayer and financially.

SPECIAL UPDATES

1. Our second secondary school has kicked off in Sierra Leone.
2. We were able to distribute free big notes and exercise books to about 500 students and teachers in all our mission schools.
3. Scholarships were given to students in Togo for their university education.
4. The first batch of students in our mission school sat for the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE).
4. Motorbikes were purchased for our missionaries in Tanzania and Guinea Conakry.
5. 7 new churches were planted in Northern Nigeria, and 140 new souls were saved. Relief materials were distributed to them.



SPECIAL CRUSADES

Open-air crusade was held in Zambia and Tanzania to reach out to more people. Also, a market storm and film outreach was organized in Tanzania and Malawi respectively. We praise God for the many souls that were saved through these activities.



Completed Projects

In the period under review, the Lord helped us to complete the following projects:

1. Tent construction for one of our churches in Togo.
2. New churches in Liberia and Sierra Leone received tapolines to cover their churches.
3. A well was dug for a community in Togo.
4. Plots of land was purchased for the Fulani converts in Niger Republic. 40 men were saved, not counting their wives and children.
5. Two churches were built and completed in Togo.

TENTMAKING FOR MISSIONARIES

The wives of missionaries in Liberia and Togo were given 50 to 100 USD to start their own businesses in order to support the family.



MISSIONARY WELFARE AND MONTHLY SUPPORT

We are grateful to God for enabling us to meet up with the monthly support for some of our field missionaries. Although some of them are not receiving anything as a result of the limited resources.

Some of them are also going for part time studies and trainings. The Lord is helping us to give them necessary assistance.



WATCHMEN VOLUNTEERS

By the grace of God, we had about 92 new volunteers join us this quarter. We experienced not only the multiplication of souls but also volunteers.
