t's been so challenging for our missionaries laboring amongst the Dukawa, Kamberi, Hausa and Fulani in these locations. Some of them were attacked, robbed and kidnaped by the Bandits. We are grateful to God for their miraculous deliverables. Our Mission church in Felele, Niger state has been covered with roofing zinc.









CAMEROON



We are grateful to God for our first Missionary to the Pygmies in Eastern Cameroon.



About 100 of them were led to Christ and two churches planted.



We also carried out some research work in the extreme North, where the Arabs and Fulanis are.

We distributed audio Bibles, foodstuffs and relief items.












Two additional churches have been planted among the Unreached Bananas, Rekas and Tupuris people group in Chad. We organised trainings for about 40 indigenous disciples and leaders and led souls to Christ.



Tapolines and some other materials were provided for the construction of their churches















In collaboration with a primary school, in jos and two volunteer teachers as organised a free evening school for our orphans. Five Muslim children who are not living in the orphanage joined the class.

The sum of 90k is being spent monthly on their feeding. Special exposure program was also organised for them





SOLAR POWERED PROJECTOR

The Lord has also provided 2 Solar powered Projectors for our church planting movement among the unreached communities in Cameroon and Tchad. We thank God for the collaborative efforts received from other mission agencies.

We are grateful to God for the progress of the work in Niger Republic. In the last three months, A special Empowerment program was organised for some women and young converts. Cream, beads etc where made at the end of the training Our second missionary base has been fenced.

We are grateful to God for our mission schools. Our primary six pupils did well in their exams, Nursery pupils graduated to primary school. Our senior Secondary school is still under construction








Volunteer and Social Media Engagements.
